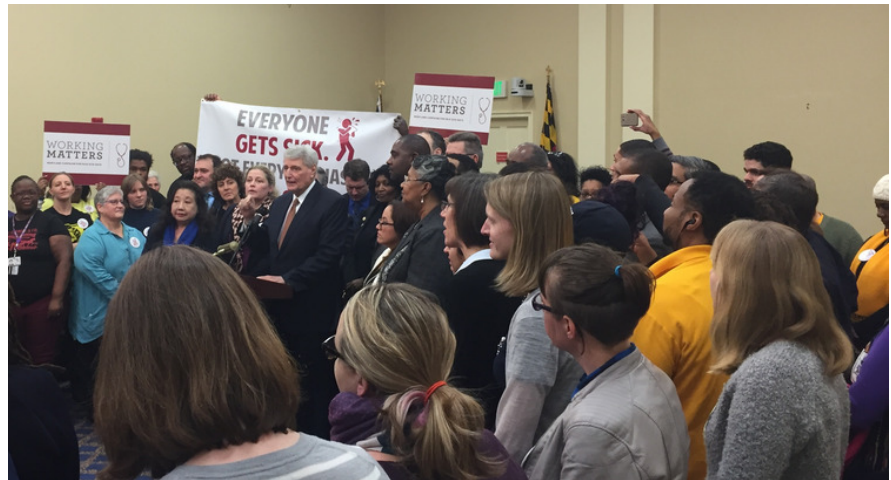

Guest speakers at the rally included Speaker Mike Busch, bill sponsor Senator Mac Middleton, bill sponsor Delegate Luke Clippinger and many more. Delegate Clippinger shared an especially heart wrenching story of his recent battle with leukemia and how access to earned sick leave allowed him to get the medical treatment he needed to get better.
