# Annapolis Update

## Governor's Budget

In a year with major revenue shortfalls, we are grateful to avoid cuts to The Associated's agencies' important social service programs. The BJC team is excited to announce that Governor Hogan's proposed Fiscal Year 2018 budget includes level funding for all of our recurring budget requests. This includes \$250,000 for the Medical Home Extender Program at Sinai Hospital, \$75,000 for the CHANA & Associated agency Elder Abuse Program, \$225,000 for the Supportive Community Network: Empowering Older Adults to Thrive in Supportive Communities, \$350,000 to help Holocaust survivors age-in-place, and \$275,000 for the Maryland-Israel Development Center. The Governor has also proposed an increase from \$5 million to \$7 million to the BOOST scholarship program for families of children attending non-public schools, and \$2 million to support construction of Sinai Hospital's new Community Primary & Specialty Care Complex.
