Our impact extends from Ukraine to Uruguay, from Madrid to Morocco, from the U.S. to Israel. Each year, Jewish Federations invest campaign dollars to our global partners to strengthen the foundation that supports our community here at home and around the world.

## Combating Antisemitism & Standing Up Against Hate

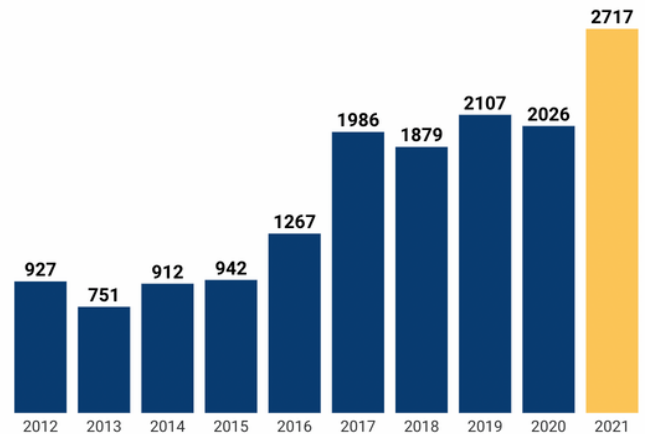
Nearly one out of every four Jews in the U.S. has been the victim of antisemitism over the past year.

South Carolina saw an increase of 67% in antisemitic incidents in 2021. We acted decisively.

In partnership with ADL (the Anti-Defamation League), your Campaign support made possible the creation of a new CJF position - the first of its kind for any Federation. Natanya Miller brings extensive ADL educational curriculum, resources, and support into our local schools and community.

Natanya has already addressed incidents of antisemitism in several schools, meeting with their administrators and providing trainings to the educators.

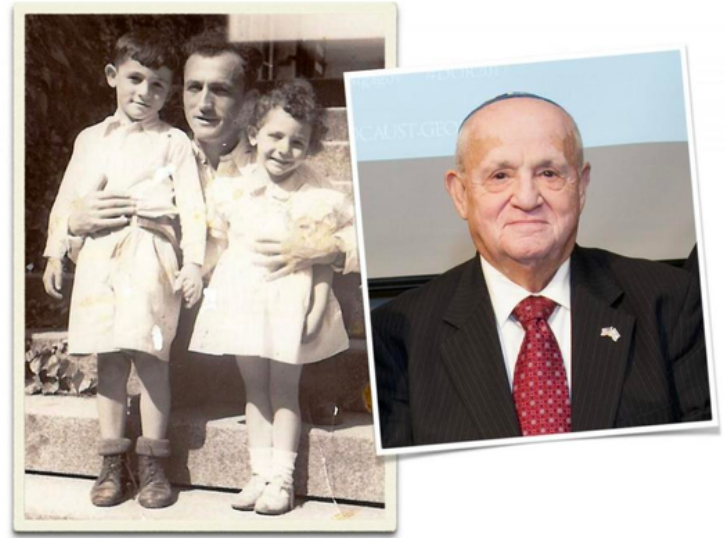




# The REMEMBER Program for Holocaust Education & Genocide Awareness

shares the lessons from the Holocaust to build community among all races, faiths, and ethnicities, and inspires local citizens to take a stand against all forms of hate.

Our Community-Wide Yom HaShoah Program - even when done virtually - gives us all the space to remember our loved ones - ancestors taken from us too soon because of discrimination and hate. In 2021, 500+ people around the world joined us for a Virtual Yom HaShoah Holocaust Remembrance Program.

In 2021 our Speaker's Bureau, consisting of Charleston area Holocaust survivors and their descendants, reached 2,425 students and community members.

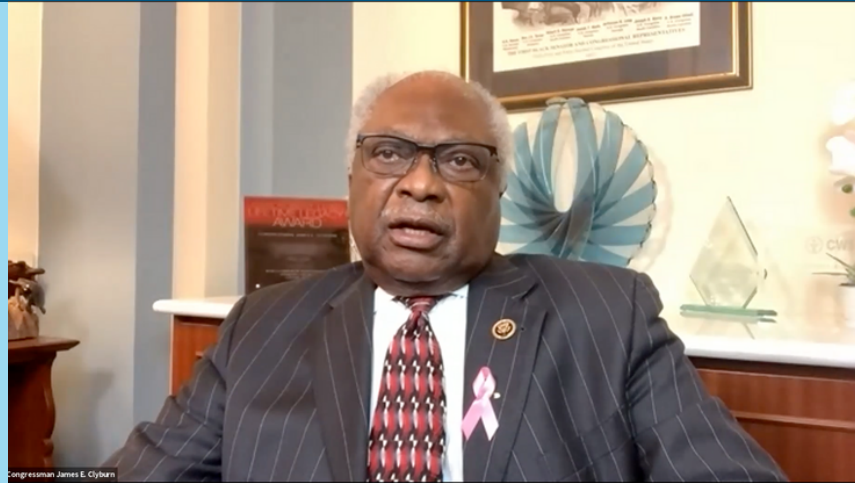

## Do Not Stand Idly By Jewish Community Relations Council

JCRC made great strides on behalf of the Jewish community in the areas of government affairs, interfaith and intergroup coalition building, combatting antisemitism and more.

JCRC focused on a number of local, state, and national priorities resulting in:

- SC House passage of a hate crimes bill for the first time in our state's history
- Local resolutions in support of Israel, against antisemitism, and all forms of hate
- Increased Federal Non-Profit Security Grant Program funding for our local synagogues
- Increased Federal funding for Holocaust education and survivors' care.
- Local law enforcement training on hate crime and Jewish community sensitivity.

## Food Outreach and Distribution

Together with our local synagogues, our Federation's JCRC focused on creating a community-wide Jewish Communal Response to Hunger to take the biggest bite possible out of food insecurity.

We continued our partnership with the Lowcountry Food Bank and grassroots neighborhood organizations to distribute over 150k pounds of fresh food affecting approximately 10k lives.

Along with food, we responded to the COVID-19 pandemic by partnering with SC DHEC to vaccinate community members with limited access to healthcare.

## Securing our Jewish Institutions and Jewish Community

**Only 1/3 of all Jewish Federations in North America have security initiatives that support their local Jewish institutions. Charleston is one of them.**



For 7 years, Charleston Jewish Federation worked steadfastly to create a security infrastructure on behalf of all of our local Jewish entities.

In 2021, Charleston and Columbia's Jewish Federations came together to cement our relationship with Secure Community Network (SCN) and welcomed Jason Roebuck as our SCN Regional Security Advisor.

The William Ackerman Volunteer of the Year Award honors those community members who exhibit exceptional leadership and who are among the first to raise their hand when a volunteer is needed.

Ellis Kahn is the embodiment of this award. He has tirelessly committed himself to the Charleston Jewish Community for decades serving on multiple Boards and raising essential funds for those in need in Charleston and abroad.

Most notably, he helped to secure funding for Operation Moses in the 1980s helping thousands of Jewish Ethiopians make Aliyah. Later, he helped to raise essential funds for Israel when they were facing attack from Hezbollah and Hamas.

We are so thankful to Ellis for his many years of service to the Charleston Jewish Community.

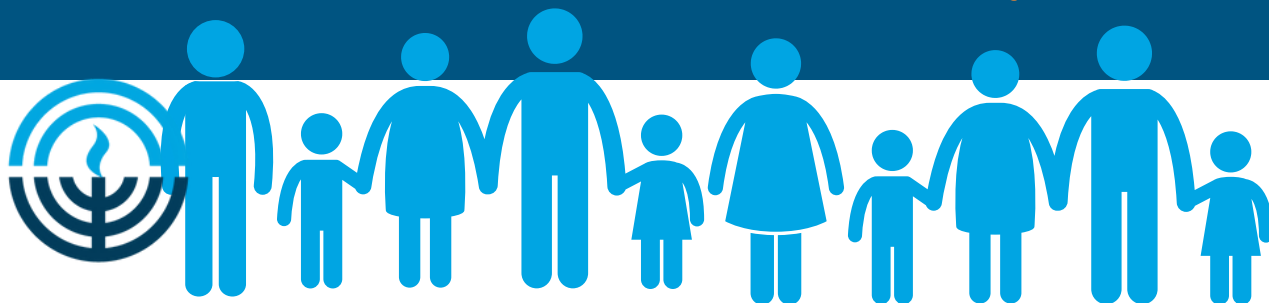

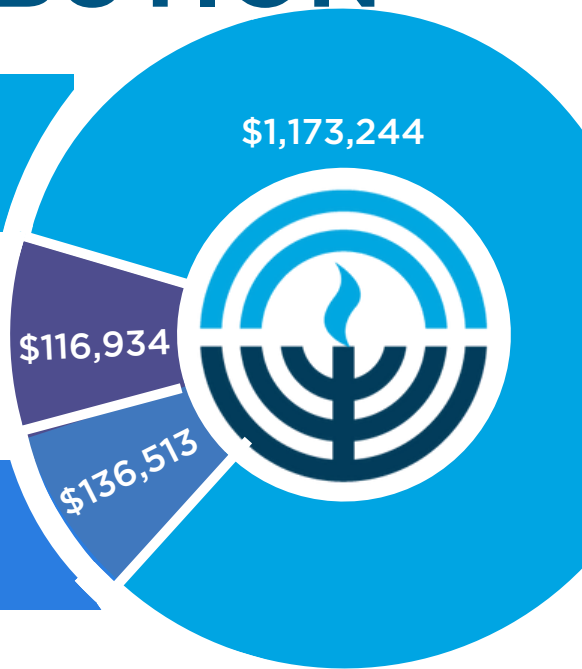

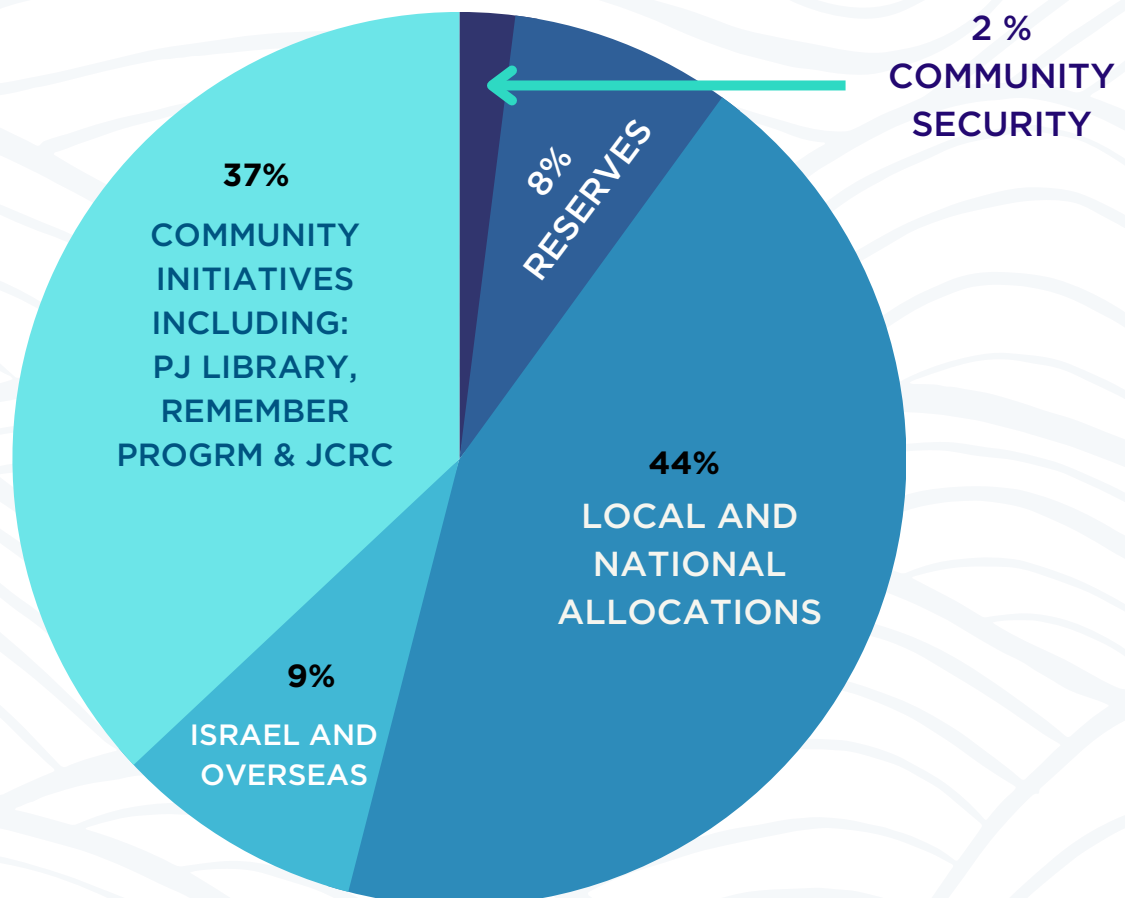
