Students recognized a need for more inclusive clubs on campus and approached me to sponsor clubs that would welcome everyone. I was happy to take on this role. Additionally, when the Chess Club sponsor left, I became the sponsor for that club as well. I believe fostering unity in our clubs is crucial. I encourage students to work together to improve our campus community by promoting inclusivity, mental health, and anti-bullying awareness through collaborative art projects. I facilitate conversations and welcome students to join the Alliance Club, Arts and Crafts Club, and the Chess Club in the Naples High School library.


Describe the lessons, and/or activities, and if adapted from another source, please reference. My sponsorship of the three clubs focuses on several key aspects. Primarily, I emphasize kindness and respect as we work towards common goals in each club. I also guide students on how to create kind and inclusive classrooms by encouraging them to speak up when necessary. During chess club, I provide support and teach respect, kindness, empathy, and sportsmanship. I reinforce anti-bullying messages in all clubs by highlighting the importance of valuing diverse opinions. To foster a sense of belonging and peer mentorship, I encourage collaboration, meaningful conversations, and the creation of artwork to beautify our campus and promote a sense of community at Naples High School.

In the Alliance Club, we use real-life scenarios to spark discussions and problem-solving, helping students develop strategies for promoting inclusivity. Through these conversations, we encourage positive communication and intercultural dialogue. Students also engage in intercultural dialogue through collaborative art projects, chess matches, and discussions. Our recent bulletin board project, created by the Art Club, showcased a powerful message of belonging through student artwork. Through these club activities, students learn to respect their peers, stand up for what is right, and advocate for justice in their daily lives. They do this through conversations, art projects, and peer mentorship.

I am honored to nominate Liddy Sexton, Media Specialist, and Julie Holt Hayford, Media Assistant at Naples High School for the Stand Up for Justice Grant for 2025. They created a library at Naples High School, which is inviting, warm, and welcoming to all students from all walks of life every day, and they teach respect for diversity, and they counter bigotry by offering a wide selection of books with historical perspectives of bravery in standing up for what is right. They also host three clubs in the library, which include students with diverse backgrounds, which are the Arts and Crafts Club, the Alliance Club, and the Chess Club.

Furthermore, this creative learning space they developed at the Naples High School Library shares a common vision, of love, inclusivity, and standing up for justice, as it is carefully decorated with inspirational posters, learning puzzle tables for students to gather and solve puzzles together, and they are always ready to lend inspiration and ingenuity to students looking for assistance in reading and finding the perfect book to prepare them for everything from essays, to participating in clubs on campus, such as the Chess Club, Alliance Club, and the Arts and Crafts Club.

Both Ms. Sexton and Ms. Holt Hayford built a kind and supportive space at the library, which include titles presenting historical and pictorial perspectives of the Civil Rights Movement in America, and other fiction and nonfiction titles, which encourage bravery for people to stand up for what is right in our society. Ms. Sexton and Ms. Holt Hayford inspire and include all of our students, including students with disabilities, and students who are mastering of reading books in the English language with the many books, technology, and creative centers they developed for our students.

Students who are active in their library, also benefit from after three school clubs, which benefit not only the students at Naples High School campus but have also benefited those who are serving in the military in the past few years. Ms. Holt Hayford created hundreds of handmade cards with her students in the Arts and Crafts Club for active military veterans serving during the holidays to bring them joy and peacefulness as they were away from their families for the holiday season.

In the Chess Club and the Alliance Club, also hosted at the Naples High School Library, students feel included, and are welcomed in with kindness, and are encouraged to have respectfulness with each other through facilitated discussions, and students are also guided though coaching chess processes as Ms. Holt Hayford can be seen helping players improve their game of chess at the library with students.

Also, Ms. Sexton often hosts professional development for educators at Naples High School to help educators fully develop research skills needed to examine and express learning theories within the curriculum of Naples High School to help students understand the importance of standing up for justice in their daily lives.
