



PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. It is the expectation of the Allocations Committee that all applicants submit a complete application by the stated deadline. Failure to meet this requirement may result in a reduced allocation or disqualification.
2. All proposed programs should serve the Greater Naples Jewish community in a meaningful, innovative, and relevant way by aligning with one or more of the following community pillars:
 - Bringing together Jews of all ages, backgrounds, and traditions in the Greater Naples area through celebrations, learning, and Jewish programming.
 - Providing education and awareness to combat anti-Semitism, ensure a safer, more resilient community, and build productive relationships with our elected and law enforcement officials.
 - Reflect our Jewish responsibility to care for the vulnerable in our communities.
 - Providing relief, rebuilding support, and foster solidarity in Israel.
3. Program must benefit the Greater Naples Jewish community and/or Jews worldwide without membership requirements.
4. Programs can be directed at a subset of the community.
5. Innovative programs, as well as programs geared toward the long-term sustainability of the Greater Naples Jewish community, will be given preference for funding.
6. Program Funding must be spent during the fiscal year of the allocation.
