AMERICAN JEWISH WORLD SERVICE: A global charity supporting 450 social justice organizations in Africa, Asia, Latin America and the Caribbean, working to fight poverty, respond to disasters and advance the rights of women, girls, LGBT people and indigenous communities.

ANTI-DEFAMATION LEAGUE: A nonprofit organization stopping anti-Semitism and defending the Jewish people; fighting cyberhate, bullying, bias in schools and in the criminal justice system, terrorism, hate crimes, coercion of religious minorities and contempt for anyone who is different.

BIRTHRIGHT ISRAEL: A nonprofit educational organization that sponsors free ten-day heritage trips to Israel for Jewish young adults 18-26 years of age.
