- Using the half sheet of paper (included), have students write or draw, and example of an act of kindness
- Brainstorm some ideas
- Here are some examples:

 - 3. Make a point to welcome a new student
 - 4. Help someone who dropped something...
 - 5. Say something nice to someone (compliment)
 - 6. Praise your peers (other students)
 - 7. Let someone go in line in front of you
 - 8. Ask if you can help
 - 9. Help someone with yard work (at home)

- Ask them to write a message (or a saying, or quote) about KINDNESS
- They can draw, decorate or just write it
- Ask them to write it as large as they can, so it can be seen from a few steps away

- They can also write it in their native language, in addition to English
- They can, but they do not have to sign their name, it is optional
