## THE ORIGIN OF THE POMEGRANATE


Throughout Jewish culture, the pomegranate is a beloved symbol. It was carved into the stone over the doors of the earliest synagogues, woven into the hems of the robes of the priests, and hammered into ceremonial silver and gold objects.

Jewish tradition teaches that the pomegranate is a symbol of righteousness as it is said to have 613 seeds, which corresponds with the 613 mitzvot, or commandments, in the Torah. The pomegranate embodies prosperity, good health, and wisdom, serving as a cherished link to our rich Jewish history.

## THE POMEGRANATE PIN

The beautiful sterling silver pin identifies you as a generous woman who builds and sustains our community. Each year, you will qualify for an additional "seed" or ruby by adding \$100 to your pledge.

By wearing the Pomegranate pin, women are reminded of their commitment to the Jewish people and a better world. More than 7,000 women across North America proudly wear the Pomegranate pin.
