

Edmonton Jewish Community Charitable Foundation - Grant Eligibility Guidelines

The Edmonton Jewish Community Charitable Foundation (EJCCF) supports growth and innovation within the Edmonton Jewish Community by providing grants for initiatives that:

- are Jewish community based,
- link with the organization's mandates and strategic plans,
- enhance capacities and assets of the local people and community,
- are funded by multiple sources,
- lead to a measurable and sustainable impact,
- respond to identified needs and priorities within the community,
- show evidence of local community support,
- and provide realistic plans for longer term funding for ongoing initiatives.

Specific Guidelines

1. Your organization must have a **Registered Charitable Business Number** which must be submitted with your request. It must be a **registered organization of the Jewish Federation of Edmonton** or **the initiative must have Jewish content and benefit the Edmonton Jewish Community.**

2. The EJCCF will give **preference** to:

- Requests for **new, innovative programs and initiatives** over ongoing or repetitive requests.
- Programs that reach and **affect a larger or broader audience.**
- Organizations who have provided a general **brief written follow up to the EJCCF** as to how the grant monies were used in the previous year(s). Submission of details such as receipts are not required.
- Organizations who have given **public recognition to the EJCCF** for the grants received. The intention is to broaden community awareness of the EJCCF to attract donors and grow the Foundation.

3. Please submit **only one request per organization.** If an organization has requested funding for multiple programs in the past, the organization now must choose the one program to be supported by EJCCF.

4. Consideration may be given to requests for multi-year funding for initiatives that may take longer than one year to achieve results. Multi-year funding may not exceed a three year time frame.

Ineligibilities The EJCCF **does not** offer grant monies for:

- Salaries, awards or sabbatical leaves,
- ongoing operational or core expenses,
- retroactive funding or future funding before the EJCCF's decision date,
- endowment matching grants,
- office equipment and furniture (exceptions may be made for unique articles),
- large scale capital and public infrastructure projects,
- debt retirement or reserves; mortgage pay downs.
