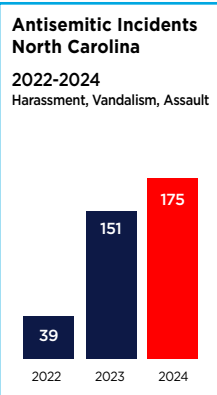
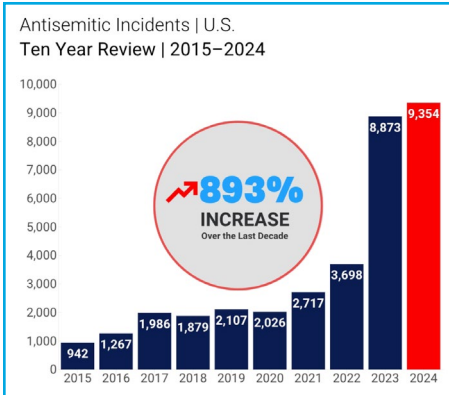




SAFETY & SECURITY

According to the **FBI's 2024 Hate Crime Report** for North Carolina, there were 68 religiously-motivated hate crimes statewide — **28 of them (41.2%) targeted the Jewish community.**

REGIONAL PARTNERSHIP FOR A SAFER JEWISH COMMUNITY

The Greensboro Jewish Federation launched a regional security program in 2023 in partnership with Durham-Chapel Hill, Raleigh, and Winston-Salem to address increased needs related to safety and security in our Jewish communities.

FROM MATCHING GRANT TO COMMUNITY COMMITMENT

In partnership with Jewish Federations of North America and the Secure Community Network, this program was funded through a 50% matching grant under the LiveSecure initiative.
