

ARTIST RESIDENCY PROGRAM FOR SENIOR ADULTS

Last year, the JCC Senior Adult Club was chosen to participate in an “Artist Residency Program with a Research Component” facilitated by Jump Street, Arts in Education. The participants enjoyed this program so much, that we decided to offer a different ten class program. It is an incredible opportunity for our seniors to work with Cheryl Kugler, a professional artist. Jump Street works in partnership with the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts to place professional artists in a setting for ten classes.

We have received a grant from the Arts for All Partnership and Jump Street, which has enabled us to cover most of our cost to offer these ten classes. We are suggesting a donation of \$15 for JCC Senior Adult Club members and a fee of \$35 for guests, plus the cost of a sketchbook, which will be approximately \$5. Arts for All Partnership is a partnership between the Cultural Enrichment Fund and the Greater Harrisburg Foundation, a regional foundation of the Foundation for Enhancing Communities.

Each class, Cheryl Kugler will introduce a different facet of “Individuality Becomes Collaboration.” Some of the activities offered will be drawing to music with a “Twist”, Tea Bag art, Index Card art, Hand Silhouette art, exploration of Canadian, contemporary and famous international artists, and a collaborative piece. We can register up to 30 people for this program, first come, first served. The group will meet one day a week for ten weeks.
