

Harrisburg JCC/Jewish Federation of Greater Harrisburg Program Refund Policy

Refund requests may be made by phone during regular business hours or in writing. Attendees who request a refund at least 24 hours before the start of a class, program, or event will receive a full refund of all tuition and fees, unless an earlier refund deadline is specified. No refunds will be issued within 24 hours of the start of a class, program, or event. If a class, program, or event is canceled by the Jewish Federation for any reason, including but not limited to weather or emergency, all paid participants will receive a full refund.

Refund Policy Notes:

- Some classes or programs may have a minimum and maximum enrollment number, which must be satisfied before a class or program will be held. Enrollment limits may vary depending upon the nature of the class and the available instructional space.
- This policy excludes programs by the JCC Summer Camp and the Brenner Early Learning Center.
- Refunds will be processed within 30 days of request or cancellation.

From Captivity to Freedom: A Powerful Conversation with Eliyah Cohen & Ziv Abud

On October 7, Eliyah and Ziv attended the Nova music festival. They fled together into a roadside bomb shelter—later known as “the bunker of death”—after terrorists attacked the shelter by throwing grenades inside. Eliyah was taken captive and held for 505 days, not knowing what happened to Ziv. He was released on February 22, 2025, and only then learned that Ziv had survived and had been fighting for his return every single day.
