## **WORKING AT CAMP SHALOM**

Camp Shalom (K-5th grade) and Camp Shalom Noar-Bogrim (6th-9th grade) look for counselors and administrative staff every summer. We look to hire enthusiastic, creative, and active counselors who are comfortable with the outdoors. Available positions include counselors, unit heads, art & nature specialists, lifeguards, and various leadership roles.

Counselors typically work in groups with 12-16 campers and 3-4 counselors. They plan and lead a variety of engaging activities, work to build a strong sense of community among campers, and maintain a physically, emotionally, and socially safe camp environment for all.
