Drop-Off

Please park your car in the Federation parking lot or on the street. The check-in desk will be outside of the front entrance gate. Markers will designate 6 feet of distance. If there are more than 3 families waiting at 1 time, please wait by your cars. Our staggered drop-off will hopefully eliminate the wait. All adults must wear masks during drop-off.

- Bet room – parents/guardians will walk children to the Bet room door.
- Gimel room - parents/guardians will walk children to the main entrance door
- Dalet room – parents/guardians will walk children to the large playground gate. If it is raining, parents/guardians will walk children to the Dalet room back door.



Pick-Up

Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your pick-up time and brightwheel message us when you arrive. We will message you back when we are ready to bring your child and all their belongings out to the parking lot. Please meet us by the check-in area once you receive our message. All adults must wear masks during pick-up.

We appreciate your promptness in picking up your child(ren) on time, so our staff can be diligent with their new cleaning routine. Please arrive no later than 10 minutes prior to your child's scheduled pick-up time.



Health Check

Each morning, all families and staff complete a health check. The health check includes:

- Temperature check
- Health question check
- Hand sanitizer application



Sick Policy

- Parent temperatures will be taken at drop-off. If the reading is 100.4 or higher, your child will not be permitted to come to Gan HaYeled until the family member is symptom free without medication for 72 hours.
- Child(ren's) temperatures will be taken at drop-off. If your child has a reading of 100.4 or higher, your child will not be permitted to come to Gan HaYeled until they are symptom free without medication for 72 hours.
- Staff temperatures will be taken daily. If a staff member has a reading of 100.4 or higher, the staff member will not return until they are symptom free without medication for 72 hours.
- Staff, children, and adults are to use hand sanitizer upon entry.
- If any siblings or immediate family members have a fever, then the child must stay home until the family members are symptom free without medication for 72 hours.
