Brown v. Board of Education Originator & Civil Rights Educator



The King Coalition welcomes Cheryl Brown Henderson as keynote speaker for the 34th Annual Madison & Dane County King Holiday Observance on January 21st.

Ms. Brown Henderson is one of the three daughters of Reverend Oliver Brown who filed suit against the local Board of Education in what became known as the landmark *Brown v. Board of Education* case. She has had a distinguished career as a civil rights advocate and educator. She has been invited to the White House on several occasions, and in 2004 she introduced then President Bush at the opening of the Brown v. Board of Education National Historic Site in Topeka, Kansas.

The program will also include performances by the *MLK Community Choir* and presentation of the *2019 MLK Humanitarian Award* by Madison Mayor Paul Soglin and County Executive Joe Parisi.
