A safe Jewish community is a strong one.

This year, Winnipeg will take a significant step forward with the hiring of a **full-time Regional Security Director** dedicated to protecting our institutions, events, and people. From building relationships with law enforcement to coordinating volunteer training and security audits, this role will ensure we are prepared and protected.

Winnipeg is becoming part of a growing national Jewish security network, working with communities across Canada to share information, standardize training, and strengthen crisis response.

# Combating Hatred and Antisemitism

### **BUILDING AWARENESS, PRESERVING TRUTH**

Understanding our history is one of the ways we protect our future.

That's why, as a community, we continue to preserve our story, from Jewish life in Manitoba dating back to the late 1800s to the testimonies of Holocaust survivors. We are proud to be home to the only Holocaust museum in Manitoba, a place of learning, memory, and truth.

Each year, thousands of students and educators engage with Holocaust and antisemitism education through presentations, resources, and school visits. These programs don't just teach history. They build empathy, challenge hate, and inspire action.

Thanks to a community-led effort made possible through your support, thousands of Manitobans participate in these education programs each year. With programming delivered by a trusted local institution, this work reaches classrooms and lecture halls across Manitoba. At the request of the Provincial Department of Education, professional development opportunities are also created to meet curriculum standards and help educators teach this vital history with confidence and care.

#### **BUILDING ALLIES, AMPLIFYING OUR VOICE**

When we show up, speak out, and build bridges, our community becomes stronger and more secure.

This year, for the first time, the Israeli flag was raised at the Manitoba Legislative Building to mark Israel's 77th Independence Day. It was a proud and meaningful moment made possible through steady, coordinated advocacy.

The Jewish Federation of Winnipeg along with our advocacy arm, CIJA, continue to elevate Jewish voices by working directly with government leaders, civil servants, and community partners. Whether advocating for stronger security measures, standing up against antisemitism, or shaping inclusive public policy, we ensure that our community's voice is heard.

A significant step forward came this year when the Jewish community was formally recognized as a leading partner in providing hate-related training to law enforcement and provincial prosecutors. It's the first time we've been invited into such a critical role, and it reflects the trust and credibility we've built.

We're also strengthening relationships with Black, Ukrainian, Christian, Mennonite, and other faith-based communities. And through a new Indigenous engagement initiative, we're building meaningful dialogue with the Manitoba Métis Federation, Inuit, and First Nations organizations.

Your support helps this work grow. Together, we're shaping how others see our community and standing proudly for what we believe in.

As a result of the work of the Federation's Public Affairs Task Force, we've shifted from reacting to challenges to proactively addressing them. From shaping government policy to school classrooms, to bridge building and community outreach, we are ensuring that our community's voice is not only heard but also trusted and respected."

When Jews around the world face hardship, we act: quickly, compassionately, and together.

Through national and international partnerships, we deliver emergency aid, help displaced families, and provide long-term support where it's needed most. From the frontlines of Israel to Ukrainian border communities and beyond, your generosity brings food, housing, trauma support, education, and dignity to Jews in crisis.

Through the newly-established Pan Canadian Coalition, we are strengthening our support for Israelis affected by war, whether still in the conflict zone, or rebuilding lives in other parts of Israel. We are also committed to continuing aid to Jewish communities still facing displacement and instability in Ukraine and elsewhere.

We grow closer through youth exchanges, school partnerships, and community visits. Every connection strengthens our sense of peoplehood across miles, languages, and generations.



BB Camp is an inclusive sleep away Jewish summer camp in Lake of the Woods, Ontario where youth learn and grow through wilderness based experiences.



#### **CAMP MASSAD**

Camp Massad is a Hebrew immersion camp where kids can learn, grow, and play in a Hebrew environment.



## GWEN SECTER CREATIVE LIVING CENTRE

Gwen Secter Creative Living Centre at Syd Glow Place promotes the physical, mental, social, and spiritual well-being of older adults; thereby promoting independent living and participation in community life.



#### IRMA PENN SCHOOL OF JEWISH LEARNING

Under the guidance of the Rabbi and School Director, children are exposed to the cultural, social, historical, and ethical aspects of Judaism. The curriculum includes the Jewish life cycle, holidays, festivals, Shabbat, Hebrew, blessings, and synagogue skills. Classes are Wednesday after school and Sunday mornings.



#### JEWISH CHILD AND FAMILY SERVICE

JCFS helps hundreds of people within our community from people who have just arrived to the oldest members of the community. Offering counselling services, financial assistance, addiction support, settlement and integration programs, and so much more.



#### JEWISH HERITAGE CENTRE OF WESTERN CANADA

The Jewish Heritage Centre of Western Canada (JHC) brings together the Jewish Historical Society of Western Canada, the Marion & Ed Vickar Jewish Museum of Western Canada, the Genealogical Institute, the Jewish Historical Society Archives, and the Freeman Family Foundation Holocaust Education Centre.



#### JEWISH LEARNING INSTITUTE

JLI offers weekly classes and seasonal courses, lectures and inspiring events, to connect you with your community and with your Jewish soul.

Rady JCC offers an extensive array of sports, cultural, recreation, fitness and wellness programs for children, youth and adults of all ages.

The Saul and Claribel Simkin Centre is a sparkling, 200-bed facility in south Winnipeg where people who can no longer live independently come to live their remaining years in dignity and with professional care, in a robust and friendly social environment steeped in Yiddishkeit.
