



THE DUBOFF FAMILY YOUTH AWARD

PURPOSE OF THE AWARD

To recognize an individual who has demonstrated outstanding service and leadership in support of the activities of the Jewish community or who shows potential for future leadership. Nominees must be 16-24 years.

The Duboff family is one of Winnipeg's noteworthy philanthropists and community leaders. Their selfless dedication to the Jewish community in Winnipeg is reflected in this award.

CRITERIA TO BE CONSIDERED

- Member of the Winnipeg Jewish Community
- Active leadership or ongoing participation within the activities of the Jewish community which may include the Jewish federation of Winnipeg and/or its beneficiary agencies, synagogues, Israel-based organizations, or other Jewish community work including general community
- Demonstrate the ability to inspire and motivate peers

NATURE OF THE AWARD

The recipient will have their name transcribed onto an originally designed Duboff Family Youth glass award.

Recipients receive a \$1,000 bursary towards participation in leadership development and will be recognized at the annual Kavod Evening.

NOMINATIONS

Nominations shall be solicited in the local Jewish media and to local communal organizations. Complete nominations are accepted online at www.jewishwinnipeg.org
