- The highest standards of professionalism
- Creativity and innovation
- Leadership
- Integrity and respect
- Knowledge and dedication in the services they provide
- Consistent job performance above and beyond normal standards
- A role model for other Jewish communal professionals and/or lay leaders
- Active in the Jewish or general community outside of their professional role
- Warm and caring interactions to all with whom they come in contact
- Contributor to current Combined Jewish Appeal (CJA) Campaign

NATURE OF THE AWARD

The recipient will have their name transcribed onto an originally designed Larry Hurtig Jewish Communal Professional glass award and will be recognized at the annual Kavod evening.
