



MAX NATHANSON YOUNG LEADERSHIP AWARD

PURPOSE OF THE AWARD

The Max Nathanson Young Leadership Award is presented to an individual volunteer who has demonstrated outstanding service and leadership in support of the activities of the Jewish Federation of Winnipeg. Nominees must be between the ages of 25 and 45.

Max Nathanson's commitment to education and his philanthropic contributions made him an inspirational figure in the Winnipeg Jewish community. This young leadership award is dedicated in his name to ensure that his legacy continues.

CRITERIA TO BE CONSIDERED

- Contributor to current Combined Jewish Appeal (CJA) Campaign
- Active leadership within the Jewish Federation of Winnipeg and/or its partner agencies.
- A demonstrated record of successes in a leadership capacity
- A demonstrated ability to inspire and motivate peers
- Consideration will also be given to active involvement in Israel-based organizations, other Jewish community work and active volunteerism in the Winnipeg community

NATURE OF THE AWARD

The recipient will have their name transcribed onto an originally designed Harry Silverberg Young Leader of Distinction glass award.

Recipients receive a \$1,000 bursary towards participation in the annual General Assembly of the Jewish Federation of North America and will be recognized at the annual Kavod Evening.

NOMINATIONS

Nominations shall be solicited in the local Jewish media and to local communal organizations. Complete nominations are accepted online at www.jewishwinnipeg.org

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee consists of: the President of Federation, Immediate Past President, Chair of CJA, Chair of CJA Women's Campaign, a representative from YAD, representatives from the Silverberg, Kanee, Nathanson, Shore, and Silverberg families and a presidential appointee.
