- \$500** – Repair or replace small wheelchair ramp at foyer entrance to synagogue
- \$550** – Walkie Talkie (Connected to community security system)
- \$600** – Installation of “RING” brand video doorbell so that building can be secure during daily morning and evening services
- \$6,000** – Chair lift for stairs going to Rabbi’s study and board room



- \$1,500** – Stop the Bleed kits (10 kits)
- \$3,000** – Transportation costs for one Yeshiva University Fellows weekend
- \$3,000** – Refurbish and replace worn hardware on many exterior doors
- \$5,000** – Repair potholes and various asphalt issues in the driveways and parking lot
- \$30,000** – Install electronic security gates in the parking lots
