_____% **Vanguard VIAS Portfolio**

VIAS has invested the portfolios 60% in stocks and 40% in bonds within the United States and internationally. We use a combination of index and actively managed Vanguard mutual funds to achieve the 60/40 mix. The objective of the portfolios are to provide long-term growth while also supporting near-term spending needs. Thus, equities are used to provide greater long-term growth potential while bonds are used to protect the portfolio in the short-term from the higher expected volatility of equities.
