### First-Time Adult Travel to Israel Flight Grant

Providing opportunities for immersive Israel experiences has long been a priority of Memphis Jewish Federation (MJF). MJF's Lemsky Endowment Fund is pleased to extend its support of Israel experiences to first-timer adults with demonstrated financial need.

Adults who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply for an Israel flight grant of up to \$1500:

- Over the age of 32
- No previous Israel travel
- Financial need that would prohibit trip participation or cause severe financial hardship
- Participating in a Memphis-based Federation, Synagogue or JCC trip to Israel.

If approved for an Israel travel grant, applicant should send Tim Wheat a copy of the coach flight receipt and a reimbursement check will be sent. Grant recipients are expected to volunteer at Super Sunday or at another Federation-sponsored event.
