Bruiser saw his friend Adeline, he ran over to say Hi.




“Hey guys!” said Adeline, “Have you noticed there are no humans outside?”. “Yes!” said Bruiser, we are looking around to see what’s going on.”

All of the dog hurried back to the wedding to see what their friends were able to do.




Elliot was missing, but Bray was about to walk down the aisle!
