Improving and securing the Jewish cemeteries of Greater New Haven

The Jewish Cemetery Association of Greater New Haven (JCAGNH) oversees the care and security of many of the over 45 Jewish Cemeteries in Greater New Haven. Since its founding, the JCAGNH has made great strides in improving and securing the cemeteries under its care.

The association was formed in 2004 to address the needs of cemeteries that were suffering from neglect because their founding synagogues or burial lodge societies had ceased to exist, or were financially unable to care for them. Fourteen distressed and orphaned cemeteries have been taken over since the fall of 2007.

The JCAGNH Board of Directors is comprised of representatives from various segments of the community, including representatives from the local Jewish cemeteries as well as the director of a local Jewish Funeral Home.

OTHER ACCOMPLISHMENTS INCLUDE:

- Replacing the dilapidated fence at the Jewell, Onyx and Fitch Street cemeteries with a beautiful new fence
- Replacing and repairing retaining walls and stairwells at the Jewell Street cemeteries
- Night lighting for the Brockett Place cemeteries in East Haven
- Working with the City of West Haven to improve the drainage on Farwell Street.
- Working with the City of New Haven to accomplish replacement and repair of Jewell and Onyx Street sidewalks
- Working with the City of East Haven to accomplish paving of Brockett Place

ONGOING WORK INCLUDES

- Restoring, repairing and managing the 14 Jewish Cemeteries in New Haven, East Haven, and West Haven.
- Regular inspection and oversight of independent Jewish cemeteries in Greater New Haven
- Coordinating central maintenance for the independent Jewish cemeteries of Greater New Haven.
- Funding and coordinating the repairing and lifting of fallen and tilted headstones and sunken footstones
- Arranging with cities and towns for police patrols, graffiti removal and drainage control.

- Meeting with synagogues and lodges to address their individual needs, and coordinate planning, as well as maintenance and restoration work
- Engaging in ongoing efforts with United Illuminating to provide night lighting
- Identifying at-risk cemeteries

LONG-TERM GOALS INCLUDE

- Assuming responsibility for at-risk cemeteries at owners' requests
- Consolidating records and preserving archives
- **Financial Management**
- The Jewish Foundation of Greater New Haven manages the JCAGNH's operating fund and restricted endowments.
