Menu (catered by Emily's Catering Group): Matzo ball soup, salad, gefilte fish, sautéed chicken breast with Francaise sauce, potato pancake, baby carrots, and all the traditional Seder items. Passover treats will follow.

Children's Menu: Matzo ball soup, salad, chicken fingers (with dipping sauces), potato latkes and applesauce, and baby carrots. Passover treats will follow.

Vegetarian option: Vegetarian Napoleon—seasonal grilled vegetables, layered with whipped sweet and mashed potatoes topped with herb infused tomato relish. Passover treats will follow.

All food will be prepared kosher for Passover style. If you believe your child would prefer the adult meal, please order and pay as an adult. **Wine for the service will be provided, but please feel free to bring your own bottle of kosher for Passover wine to enjoy with dinner.**
