**BREAK THE HATE: THE NEW ANTI-SEMITISM ON COLLEGE CAMPUS**  
*Human Rights Expert Ken Marcus to Speak to Local Students at JCC on Apr. 12*

WOODBIDGE, Connecticut; April 1, 2015 – Results of *The National Demographic Survey of American Jewish College Students Anti-Semitism Report* conducted in 2014 and released Feb. 23, 2015, by a Trinity College research team indicate that Anti-Semitism on college campuses is has become a nationwide problem.

“The patterns and high rates of anti-Semitism that were reported were surprising,” said one of the researchers. “Rather than being localized to a few campuses or restricted to politically active or religious students, this problem is widespread. Jewish students are subjected to both traditional prejudice and the new political anti-Semitism.”

In response to this growing and troubling phenomenon, The Jewish Federation of Greater New Haven is bringing Ken Marcus, founder and president of the Louis D. Brandeis Center for Human Rights Under Law, to address this issue with the community and specifically with high school students looking ahead to college. The special program is Sunday, April 12, 2015, 2–4:30pm at the JCC of Greater New Haven, 360 Amity Rd., Woodbridge.

After the presentation, students will gather for a meal and take part in a series of speed-stations to speak with current college students about their personal campus experiences and to learn strategies for responding to anti-Semitism.
