**INTERNATIONAL SUPERSTAR NOA PERFORMS IN NEW HAVEN APR. 24**

*Catch Israel's Leading Concert & Recording Artist at Battell Chapel*

WOODBIDGE, Connecticut; April 2, 2013 – Israeli singer-songwriter Noa, who recently earned international praise for recording classic Israeli songs with the Jerusalem Symphony Orchestra, will return to North America this month to perform cultural treasures created by Israel's most illustrious songwriters.

*The Israeli Songbook* Tour, which stops in New Haven at Battell Chapel on April 24, 2013, coincides with Yom HaAtzmaut, Israel's Independence Day, April 15.

Noa is widely recognized as one of the world's greatest vocalists and song interpreters. She has appeared with major Symphony Orchestras and superstars of rock. She has headlined at Carnegie Hall, the Kodak Theater, the Max in Detroit, Place des Arts, Lincoln Center, and hundreds of other major venues throughout the world. For many years she was invited to perform at the gatherings of the World Financial Forum and performed for hundreds of thousands at the Vatican and at the White House on the first anniversary of Itzhak Rabin's assassination.

On *The Israeli Songbook*, Noa and virtuoso guitarist Gil Dor pay homage to songs that have inspired them personally and molded Israeli culture and consciousness. The deep, poetic lyrics and the beautiful compositions represent the best the Hebrew language's musical tradition has to offer.
