

OKC JEWISH FEDERATION COMMUNITY POOL RULES

1. Lifeguards must be obeyed at all times! Entry into the pool area is only permitted when lifeguards are on duty and the pool is open.
2. Swimmers must thoroughly rinse off before entering the pool.
3. Swimmers must wear swim suits in the pool. Cutoffs, shorts, or other street clothing are not allowed.
4. Remember that lifeguards are not baby-sitters. Children younger than 12 years old **must be accompanied at all times** by a parent or an adult over 18 who must remain within reach of the child.
5. Persons with open sores, blisters or cuts; sore or inflamed eyes; nasal or ear discharge; or any communicable disease cannot enter the pool without written permission from a medical professional. Do not enter the pool if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or if you have had any signs or symptoms of stomach disease in the previous seven days.
6. Small children **must be potty trained** in order to be in the big pool or must be wearing a “swimmie” and rubber swim pants that fit snugly at the waist and legs with their bathing suits. Disposable diapers are not allowed in the pool.
7. Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the pool and at regular intervals. Immediately report any “accidents” you observe in the pool to a lifeguard.
8. Parents/Guardians are required to make sure their children and/or guests comply with all pool rules and instructions from lifeguards.
9. *Only* children younger than 6 may be in the wading pool and **they must be accompanied by an adult at all times.**
10. For safety reasons, the following are not allowed in the pool or the adjacent areas: Any conduct that endangers the safety and/or comfort of anyone at the pool including running, diving, rough housing, distracting the lifeguards, spitting, and annoying other swimmers in any way.
11. Breakable and/or dangerous items such as glassware, alcohol, tobacco products and weapons of any kind **are never allowed in the pool or in adjacent areas of the pool.**
12. Lifeguards have the right to ban anyone from the pool who they believe is a threat to themselves or others, who is abusing pool/Temple property, or who is not following pool rules.
13. Floaties, tubes, and other water toys are permitted **at the discretion of the lifeguards.**
14. Please be respectful of the property. Pick up all your trash when you leave the pool area.
15. The playground equipment closest to the pool is for children under the age of 6 years old. **Parents are required to supervise their children** when they are utilizing the playground equipment.
16. Locker rooms are available for bathrooms and changing. Be sure to remove all your items from the locker rooms after use.
17. Children must be accompanied and supervised when in the locker rooms in the Temple; no one is allowed in other parts of the Temple building.
18. The pool will close for dangerous or inclement weather, emergency operational repairs and when it has been rented for a private party.
19. Finger food and non-alcoholic drinks are allowed in the pool area provided they are not in glass containers.
