A Message From Our Leadership

Dear Friends,

We remain committed to amplifying Jewish life and sustaining our Jewish future.

We are deeply grateful for your unwavering support of Jewish Federation of Orange County. Together, in 2023, we continued to strengthen Jewish life in Orange County, Israel, and beyond. We are proud to count you among the 2,400 generous community members who helped us raise over \$5 million, fueling our Annual Campaign and supporting vital programs, services, and grants essential to our community.

In the immediate aftermath of October 7, our community responded to the horrors committed by Hamas, showing our solidarity with Israel by mobilizing political support and by contributing over \$1 million to our local Israel Emergency Campaign. Further, our collective effort, Jewish Federations of North America, has helped raise an unprecedented \$830 million dollars to support Israel in its time of need. These critical funds provide support of four strategic priorities: medical and trauma relief, lifeline services, community resilience and rebuilding, and economic relief and recovery. We know there is a long-road ahead and we will remain united in our efforts to stand with Israel and in our commitment to combat antisemitism.

Locally, Federation's Rose Project addresses the antisemitism Jewish students encounter on college campuses and in K-12 schooling. In 2023, we strengthened relationships with partners at colleges and in OC public school districts, and we expanded our Student to Student program. This peer-to-peer leadership program debunks commonly held antisemitic beliefs, improving the campus climate by using peer education that includes sharing narratives that are centered in Jewish pride, and work to create a more inclusive experience of schooling.

Sparking Jewish identities, strengthening communal belonging, and caring for individuals in need remain central to our mission. This Impact Report showcases our collective accomplishments. Thanks to your generosity, our programs have positively impacted thousands of people in Orange County, Israel, and worldwide.

Your commitment to the Jewish future has changed lives and helped us strengthen Jewish identity. We thank you for living generously.

October 7 and Beyond

ORANGE COUNTY COMMUNITY GATHERING FOR ISRAEL

On October 10, 2023, we convened our community congregations and organizations as well as over 1,500 community members to express unwavering solidarity following the tragic events of October 7. Among the distinguished speakers were the Consul General of Israel in Los Angeles, federal and county elected officials, clergy and representatives from 15 Orange County Jewish institutions, and the parents of an IDF soldier. Together, we mourned the fallen, prayed for the injured and traumatized, and raised our voices as one in calling for the return of the hostages.



NATIONAL SOLIDARITY MARCH FOR ISRAEL

On November 16, 2023, Federation mobilized a delegation of 30 community members as we joined the March for Israel in Washington, D.C., hosted by Jewish Federations of North America and the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations. With 290,000 in person and another 250,000 online, we came together as a united community to advocate against antisemitism, fight for the release of all the hostages, and stand in strong solidarity with Israel.

HOSTING FAMILY OF HOSTAGES

At our Annual Meeting and Election of the 2024 Board of Directors on December 4, 2023, we welcomed Israeli guest speakers Ayelet Sella, Dafna Sella, and Or Sella. Their family suffered the loss of three members and the kidnapping of nine others at the hands of Hamas. Our audience of 100 community members were deeply moved to hear firsthand about the unfathomable horror of this atrocious act of terrorism and the trauma of the ongoing war. The Sellas reminded us of the resilience of the Israeli spirit in times of tragedy and reinforced the importance of Federation support which provides much-needed hope for Israeli families.

ISRAEL EMERGENCY CAMPAIGN

When Israel needed us most, our community came together in a powerful statement of support. Over 1,000 community members contributed over \$1 million to the Israel Emergency Campaign between October 7 and December 31, 2023. We responded to the crisis quickly, granting approximately half a million dollars to Jewish Federations of North America for immediate and essential humanitarian aid, with another half million in the pipeline for 2024 distribution.

Impact By The Numbers **ISRAEL GRANTS**

As of August 2024, we distributed over \$1.25 million in support of Israel since October 7, ensuring vital assistance reaches those who need it most. These grants were made possible by \$931,485 in our community's extraordinary support through the Israel Emergency Campaign and Israel-designated giving, in addition to \$320,000 in matching funds from Federation's Leon Ninburg Israel Emergency Fund. Federation, in partnership with Jewish Federations of North America (JFNA), the Jewish Agency for Israel (JAFI), the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee (JDC), and Chabad, has worked diligently to amplify Orange County's impact, ensuring that your contributions reach those in greatest need in Israel. Combating Antisemitism

CHAMPIONING INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

There can be no greater influence on humanity than in educating our future leaders. Following the announcement that California would mandate the teaching of Ethnic Studies as part of the high school curriculum, Federation established a task force to actively engage in conversations with leadership at school districts, elected officials, and other stakeholders at the local, state, and national levels to address concerns related to antisemitism, anti-Israel bias, and other problematic content in the deployment of the Ethnic Studies curriculum. Through the work of our Rose Project, Federation partnered with the Institute of Curriculum Services to provide a review and recommendations for strengthening the curriculum to ensure the course content was not biased against Israel and did not stigmatize Jews.

STUDENT TO STUDENT 4,000 STUDENTS REACHED

In the school year that began in September 2023, 54 Student to Student (STS) teen ambassadors reached nearly 4,000 students and educators through over 75 presentations in dozens of middle and high schools across Orange County. Through this high-impact program, Jewish teens provided peer advocacy to reduce prejudice, dispel negative stereotypes, and combat antisemitism. Teachers have reported that this program is an important antidote to bigotry and intolerance. STS grew exponentially last year, doubling the number of teen ambassadors, and nearly quadrupling the audience of students and teachers touched by their presentations.

Sustaining Our Jewish Future

TEEN ENGAGEMENT & WELLNESS INITIATIVE

490

JEWISH TEENS

In December 2022, Jewish Federation's Teen Engagement & Wellness Initiative approved grants totaling \$240,000 to six programs proposed by cross-denominational community partners. The programs, implemented in 2023, engaged 490 Orange County teens and tweens through mental wellness retreats, projects helping teens prepare for life and challenges on college campuses, and more. In the fall of 2023, a professional evaluation was completed, and grantees were provided coaching to strengthen their outreach and retention. In December 2023, the second year of Teen Engagement & Wellness Initiative renewal grants were awarded to five partners for 2024 implementation: Chabad of Mission Viejo (CTeen), Congregation B'nai Israel, Orange County Hillel, Merage Jewish Community Center, and the Jewish Educators Association of Orange County. These grants help our Jewish community tackle the perpetual challenge of teens opting out of Jewish life, and address the need for multiple doorways to wellness resources that support Jewish teens.

PJ Library resources, including books and programs, play a crucial role in sparking meaningful conversations within families and fostering the development of a profound Jewish identity. These resources serve as gateways for families to embark on journeys that delve into the rich tapestry of Jewish heritage, culture, and traditions.

PASSPORT TO JEWISH LIFE

93 PASSPORT GRANTS


In March 2023, Passport grants were awarded to 25 immersive Jewish summer programs to support 93 Orange County children and teens in strengthening their Jewish identity and creating lifelong memories. From 2007 through 2023, we have provided nearly \$1.7 million in Passport grants to immersive programs attended by our youth.

In 2023, over 20,000 books were delivered to OC Jewish children through PJ Library & PJ Our Way, bringing Jewish narratives into their homes and significantly forming their Jewish identities. In addition, our dedicated staff extended support by distributing more than 150 baby bags to new parents, and organized over 53 low-barrier family events, creating inclusive spaces where families can come together, celebrate their heritage, and strengthen their bonds through shared experiences.



Caring For Those In Need

Lifelines Social Services

For over 20 years, Jewish Federation's Lifelines Social Services program has helped community members in need as they weather a period of crisis and move towards economic self-sufficiency. In 2023, 450 households benefitted from case management, referrals, gift cards, and grants for housing and Jewish burials.



Holocaust Survivor Program

Jewish Federation is committed to supporting the most vulnerable members of our community, maintaining that each life be respected and valued and that our seniors age with dignity. Through our innovative partnership with Jewish Family Service of San Diego, 190 Holocaust survivors in Orange County received over 90,000 hours of exceptional care and socialization opportunities in 2023, which kept them connected to each other and our Jewish community. One of the year's highlights was a b'nai mitzvah ceremony for 60 Holocaust survivors. It was a joyful day that showcased the resilience, strength, and power of the Jewish community.

People with Disabilities

Over 2,000 hours of joy-filled Jewish programs took place at Federation-established Mandel House and Horwitz Family House, and monthly programs of our Jeremiah Society hosted by Temple Bat Yahm, Congregation Shir Ha-Ma'alot, Temple Beth Tikvah, and Beth Jacob Congregation of Irvine.

Giving Societies

WOMEN'S PHILANTHROPY

Women's Philanthropy inspires purposeful and passionate giving among women donors in Orange County. Their council, comprised of 40 women, develops dedicated leaders who engage, empower, and educate our community and strives to foster a culture of philanthropy and volunteerism. Last year, \$1.8 million was raised from 1,000 women philanthropists in Orange County to support local and overseas needs.

In 2023, Women's Philanthropy launched The Circle, a Jewish Women's professional networking group. In its inaugural year, the Circle engaged 98 career-focused Jewish women, supported them in building their professional network, and connected them meaningfully to the Orange County Jewish community. Guest speakers over three programs ranged from a woman-focused estate planning seminar to a networking technique coaching session.



SOLOMON SOCIETY

Solomon Society members foster camaraderie and fuel their passion for community-building by sharing meaningful experiences and taking on the responsibility for making a positive difference in Orange County and around the world. Last year, \$1.9 million was raised from 320 Solomon Society members to support local and overseas needs.

In March 2023, a group of 24 Solomon Society members traveled to Israel and Dubai for the Israel@75 Mission, experiencing Federation's impact and the work of our overseas partners. Mission participants met with dignitaries and business leaders in Israel and Dubai, and toured programs throughout Israel, including a visit to our sister city, Kiryat Malachi. Moved by these experiences, participants donated \$20,000 to NATAL: Israel Trauma & Resiliency Center and the Jewish Agency for Israel Victims of Terror Fund.


