Jewish Federation of Orange County exists to amplify Jewish life and sustain the Jewish future in Orange County, Israel, and globally.

A Message From Our Leadership

We are grateful for your support of Jewish Federation of Orange County. At a time when Jewish communities worldwide face unprecedented challenges, in 2024, we came together—stronger, prouder, and more united than ever—to support, uplift, and empower one another.

Thanks to your generosity, Jewish Federation of Orange County raised over \$4.7 million from more than 1,700 donor households, ensuring that vital programs and services continue to enrich and sustain Jewish life locally, in Israel, and across the world. These numbers are more than statistics—they represent lives changed, futures shaped, and a Jewish community that stands resilient in the face of adversity.

Through your support, we are strengthening Jewish identity and connection at every stage of life. In 2024, we provided 18,800 books to over 1,200 families through PJ Library, igniting a love for Jewish learning in our youngest community members. 898 teens found meaning and belonging through our Teen Engagement & Wellness Initiative, while 108 children accessed transformative Jewish educational experiences through Passport to Jewish Life grants. These programs are planting the seeds of Jewish pride that will grow for generations to come.

We continue to stand at the forefront of combating antisemitism and ensuring Jewish students feel safe and supported in Orange County. Last year, our Student to Student program trained 70 Teen Ambassadors, who reached over 4,000 high school students—helping to dismantle harmful stereotypes and build bridges of understanding.

At the heart of our work is the deeply rooted Jewish value of caring for those in need. Federation's Holocaust Survivor Program provided over 80,000 hours of at-home care to 131 Holocaust survivors, allowing them to age with dignity and security. Our Lifelines Social Services initiative supported 362 community members with financial, burial assistance, mental health resources, and emergency aid to those facing crisis.

We do this work because we believe in the strength of our community. We believe in its resilience, its generosity, and its unwavering commitment to a vibrant Jewish future. This Impact Report is a testament to all that we have accomplished—together.

We are incredibly proud of what we have built and even more determined to continue this important work. Thank you for your dedication. Thank you for your passion. Thank you for proving, year after year, that the power of community is unstoppable.

Our Programs

Jewish Federation of Orange County convenes, engages, and leads the Orange County Jewish community and its partners, leverages its resources to enhance and sustain Jewish life, assists people in need, mobilizes on issues of concern to the local Jewish community, and strengthens the bond with Israel and Jewish people globally.



Strengthening Jewish Identity

PJ Library

PJ Library is a cornerstone initiative that sparks Jewish connection from an early age by delivering free, carefully selected Jewish children’s books each month. These books inspire meaningful conversations, foster Jewish values, and create lasting family traditions around Jewish holidays and life-cycle events. **In 2024 alone, Federation delivered 18,800 books to more than 1,200 local families**, cultivating stronger family bonds and establishing foundational connections within the wider Jewish community.

Passport to Jewish Life

Passport to Jewish Life ensures every Jewish child in Orange County has access to deeply enriching Jewish experiences. Since its inception in 2007, this initiative has provided over \$1.8 million in need-based grants enabling children to participate in transformative activities like Jewish summer camps, youth retreats, leadership programs, and educational visits to Israel. **In 2024, these grants opened new horizons for 108 local children**, creating vibrant memories and lasting friendships and significantly enhancing their sense of Jewish identity and belonging.

Teen Engagement & Wellness Initiative

The Teen Engagement & Wellness Initiative addresses the unique emotional, social, and spiritual needs of adolescents within our community. Through engaging programming, peer support, leadership training, and targeted wellness resources, this initiative promotes positive mental health, resilience, and a strong sense of Jewish identity. **In 2024, Federation provided grants to five community organizations that reached 898 teens**, offering workshops, community service projects, mentorship, and Jewish learning experiences, empowering our youth to become confident, compassionate, and connected community leaders.

NextGen

Federation’s NextGen program engages young adults in their 20s, 30s, and 40s, cultivating the next generation of Jewish leaders through meaningful connection, leadership development, and community-building experiences. **In 2024, NextGen provided 12 diverse opportunities**, including social events, leadership training, networking opportunities, and volunteer initiatives, allowing young adults to connect deeply with their peers and their Jewish identities. Through these efforts, NextGen continues to build a vibrant, connected, and empowered community of young Jewish adults poised to lead and shape the future of Jewish life in Orange County.

2 Community Support and Social Services

Lifelines Social Services

Lifelines Social Services provides vital support to community members facing crises, financial hardships, and emotional challenges. Through personalized care plans, emergency financial assistance, burial assistance, and resources, Lifelines ensures community members never face hardships alone. **In 2024, 362 individuals received support**, reaffirming the Federation's commitment to compassion and community care.

Holocaust Survivor Program

In partnership with Jewish Family Service of San Diego, Federation's Holocaust Survivor Program offers compassionate care to survivors residing in Orange County, enabling them to live with dignity, independence, and security. **In 2024, Federation provided over 80,000 hours of at-home care for 131 Holocaust survivors**, addressing their unique emotional, physical, and social needs while honoring their resilience and contributions to our community.

People with Disabilities

Federation fosters inclusion, connection, and community engagement through programs for individuals with disabilities through Jeremiah Society, Mandel House, and the Horwitz Family House. **In 2024, we offered 10 programs spanning social, educational, and recreational activities**, ensuring that everyone feels valued and integral to our Jewish community.

Combating Antisemitism

Highlight: Countering Hate Summit

In 2024, Jewish Federation of Orange County’s Rose Project partnered with University of California, Irvine to host the Countering Hate Summit, a landmark event attracting hundreds of community members, law enforcement personnel, educators, students, civic leaders, and policymakers. The summit tackled the increasing concerns around antisemitism, hate speech, and discrimination, offering participants actionable strategies and practical tools to effectively confront these challenges.

Through engaging panels, interactive workshops, and impactful breakout sessions, participants explored critical topics such as responding to hate incidents, fostering inclusive environments, and enhancing collaboration among law enforcement, educators, and community leaders. The event featured prominent national and local experts who provided valuable insights, shared successful community-based strategies, and encouraged proactive community engagement.

The summit emphasized solidarity, education, and collective action, equipping attendees with essential skills and knowledge to become powerful advocates in combating hate in their communities. Federation’s Countering Hate Summit demonstrated the collective strength and resolve of the Orange County community to foster a safer, more inclusive, and respectful society.



Rose Project

The Rose Project raises and applies funds for targeted programs and activities that advance the values, interests, and security of the Jewish community, fostering a more coordinated and interconnected set of Orange County stakeholders. In 2024, the Rose Project continued to foster strategic partnerships among educational institutions, civic leaders, and law enforcement to protect Jewish life and enhance public understanding.

Rose Ambassadors Program

In late 2024, Federation proudly launched the Rose Ambassadors program, equipping adults from diverse backgrounds—whether or not they are affiliated with a religion—with the skills to effectively counter antisemitism and anti-Israel bias. Rose Ambassadors build bridges in our broader community by speaking up against hate, spreading awareness, and recruiting others to become active upstanders. The program provides comprehensive education on antisemitism, Jewish identity, and issues involving Israel, empowering Ambassadors to foster meaningful dialogue and advocate for understanding.

Student to Student Program

Student to Student trains high school students to serve as ambassadors who openly share their Jewish experiences, beliefs, and practices with peers from diverse backgrounds. Ambassadors engage in candid, personal dialogues aimed at dispelling myths, confronting stereotypes, and promoting mutual respect. **In 2024, the program empowered 70 ambassadors who reached over 4,000 high school students** and was recognized by the Orange County Board of Education for fostering more inclusive school environments throughout Orange County.

Our Impact in Israel

Israel Emergency Campaign

In 2024, the Orange County Jewish community continued to stand in unwavering solidarity with Israel through Federation's Israel Emergency Campaign. Thanks to our community's generosity, we contributed over \$1.25 million, including \$200,000 to small business loans as well as organizations on the ground in Israel focused on mental health and trauma support. These organizations impacted thousands, ensuring immediate relief, ongoing support, and sustained recovery and resilience in Israeli society.

Impact Spotlight

Omri's Story – Healing Invisible Wounds

Omri, a 27-year-old architecture student, had his life dramatically altered after being called to reserve duty on October 7, 2023. As a tank commander, Omri bravely led his platoon through intense combat in Gaza. His experience turned tragic when their tank was hit by two rocket-propelled grenades, leaving Omri and his fellow soldiers severely injured. Omri suffered significant shrapnel wounds, and the months that followed were filled with painful rehabilitation, physical therapy, and emotional distress.

"My injury really changed my perspective about life in general and about the fragility of the human body," Omri reflects.

During his recovery, Omri connected with B'shvil Hamachar, **an organization that received funding from Jewish Federation of Orange County** dedicated to supporting the mental health of combat reservists. Initially hesitant, Omri attended a therapeutic retreat, where he found a supportive community of fellow reservists who shared similar traumatic experiences.

The retreat provided Omri with practical tools for managing his trauma and post-traumatic symptoms, significantly aiding his journey toward recovery. Omri's experience is a powerful testament to the transformative impact of community support and the vital role our Federation plays in providing healing beyond the battlefield.

Women's Philanthropy

Women's Philanthropy empowers women to harness their collective strength, passion, and resources to enrich Jewish life and create a meaningful impact in the community. Through philanthropy, leadership development, and volunteerism, members deepen their connection to Jewish values and each other, building lasting relationships while supporting vital community programs. **In 2024, Women's Philanthropy achieved a significant milestone, surpassing 100 Lions of Judah**, recognizing an extraordinary group of women whose leadership and generosity profoundly impact our Jewish community. The signature annual event, Women's VOICES, highlights inspiring stories of women leaders and change-makers, celebrating their contributions and reinforcing the Federation's mission of strengthening the Jewish future.



Women’s VOICES

On March 14, 2024, Jewish Federation of Orange County hosted its annual Women’s VOICES event, **gathering over 600 local women philanthropists to celebrate the impact of women’s leadership and generosity in our community.** The event featured Noa Tishby, bestselling author and former Special Envoy for Combating Antisemitism, who delivered an inspiring keynote emphasizing the importance of collective action and community resilience. “Our shared commitment to a vibrant Jewish future matters now more than ever,” Tishby stated, highlighting the essential role women play in shaping an inclusive and supportive environment.

The event also honored **Heather Kline, the 2024 Woman of the Year** and immediate past chair of Federation’s board and executive committee. In accepting the honor, Kline emphasized the critical juncture facing the Jewish community and urged



attendees to transform inspiration into actionable support for local and global Jewish initiatives. “We find ourselves in a hineini moment,” Kline said, advocating passionately for continued dedication to celebrating Jewish life and strengthening solidarity with Israel.

Women’s VOICES serves as a cornerstone event of the Jewish Federation of Orange County’s Women’s Philanthropy, highlighting women’s diverse Jewish journeys and their collective efforts to enhance community life.

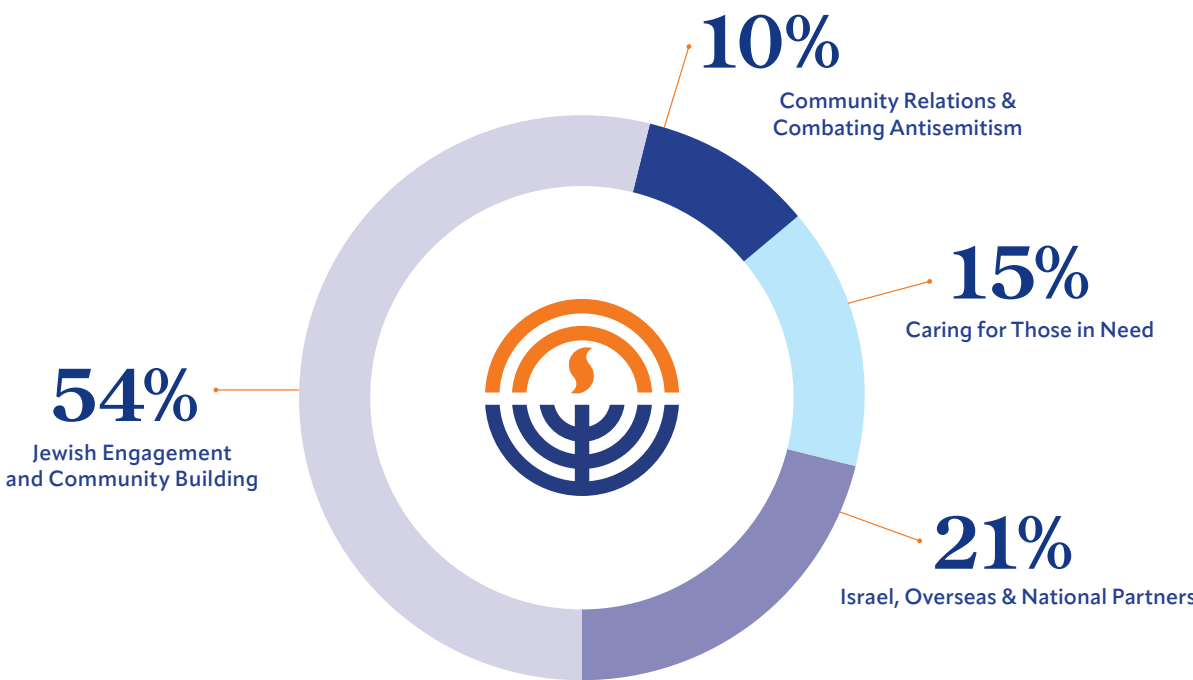
