

BUILDING JEWISH IDENTITY Summer Camp

Last year more than 8,000 children attended Jewish summer camps around the world with support from Jewish Federation and the Jewish Agency for Israel (JAFI). COLLEGE STUDENTS Vanderbilt Hillel



Vanderbilt Hillel, in partnership with Hillel's at Universities across Tennessee, serves the religious, social and educational needs of the Jewish students on campus by creating meaningful Jewish experiences throughout the year. **Currently, more than 1,500 Jewish students are connecting with their Jewish peers, but there are 500 Jewish students who are being underserved due to a lack of resources.** With increased support, we could reach the additional 33%.

Shalom Taxi has provided vital transportation for doctor visits, social experiences, grocery shopping. Our community has seen a 98% growth in ridership, increasing from 37 rides per month to 73 rides per month. Usage is predicted to increase by 20% in 2018. Help us keep them independent.
