All scholarship recipients will be asked to submit a photo and paragraph or article to be included in the Shalom about their experience upon their return from camp or their program.

All requests must be made 60 days prior to the start of the program.

Jewish Summer Camp Award – up to \$250

For families with children who attend a Jewish Summer Camp. Apply separately for each child.

Leadership Training Award – up to \$150

For high school students that enroll in leadership training programs through Jewish youth movements such as BBYO (B'nai B'rith Youth Organization). Award toward the cost of registration and travel. One award per student per year.

<u>High School Israel Experience Award – up to \$250</u>

For high school students who participate in programs designed to provide a meaningful and exciting Israel experience. Award toward the cost of registration and travel.

College and Post Graduate Study in Israel Award – up to \$500

For college and post-graduate students enrolled in academic programs in Israel or who wish to pursue internship opportunities in Israel. Must be affiliated with an accredited college/university.
