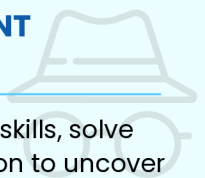

## Our Staff

Our dedicated camp staff is carefully selected each season. They each possess necessary skills, experience, and a genuine interest in working with children. They are excellent role models and mentors, bringing creativity and enthusiasm to camp every day. All staff receive training prior to and during the camp season to ensure they are providing the highest quality care for all children.

## Dates & Times

Camp J will run Monday June 8, 2026 – Friday July 31, 2026. Drop off is at 8:45 AM, Pick up is at 4:00 PM, with extended hours available from 7:30 AM – 6:00 PM.

**Open house** for registered families will be on Thursday June 4, 2026.

## Extended Care

AM and PM care are available throughout the summer for an additional fee.

**AM Care Hours:** 7:30 – 9:00 A.M.

**PM Care Hours:** 4:00 – 6:00 P.M.

Drop-in fees for extended care will be charged for any camper arriving earlier than 8:40 AM or picked up later than 4:20 PM, if not registered for the session.

## Swimming

Swimming is a summer necessity! At Camp J, we're prepared with Red Cross Certified Lifeguards. Every specialty camp will have one recreational swim period each day. Keff will have one hour of swimming daily, including a group lesson and recreational swim—weather permitting.

## Lunch & Snack

The JCC facilities are kosher. Please ensure your child's lunch is meat-free (dairy or parve). Please refer to our website for a list of lunch and snack suggestions. Any camper that does not have lunch for the day will be provided a sandwich and lunchtime snacks for a \$5 fee. Each Friday, a pizza lunch is provided for all campers at no additional cost.

## Registration Fees

Registration fees are supplemental to the camp tuition per session. Registration fees are non refundable regardless of changes to enrollment after initial registration.

## Discounts

### JCC Memberships

JCC members can save on summer camp, but camp is open to all regardless of membership status.

### Sibling Discount

We are happy to offer a sibling discount of 10% off for each additional child.

### Financial Assistance is Available

Families in need of scholarship are encouraged to submit an application— limited financial assistance is available. You must register your child for camp before applying for financial assistance. All details regarding your application are kept confidential. The financial aid application is available on our website.

## Registration & Withdrawals Policies

▶ JCC account must be current in order to be eligible for program registration.

▶ **All camp payments are due 29 days prior to the start date** of selected camp program(s).

Payment plans are available.

▶ **Credit card payments will incur a transaction fee.** Payment plans will not be charged a transaction fee when paid with an attached bank account (ACH). All manual payments will be assessed a transaction fee.

▶ No member rate discounts will be applied within 30 days of a session start date.

▶ **Campers may be placed on a WAIT LIST if a camp session is full;** spots will be offered sequentially in order of date joined if space becomes available.

▶ All camps are contingent upon sufficient registrations.

▶ All children participating in Camp J **must have a current immunization record on file.** We do not accept religious or philosophical exemptions.

▶ **All waivers must be signed** by a parent in order for a child to attend camp.

▶ **Camp program transfer requests must be made in writing** at least ten days prior to the session start date.

▶ **Any program change made after initial registration will incur a \$35 change fee,** including transferring camps or sessions, correcting a registration or any other programming changes made at the parent's request.

▶ **All withdrawal requests must be submitted in writing at least 30 days in advance of the session start date. Payments will be refunded less the registration fee.**
