Security	 Single point of contact at the Tampa Police Department, Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office, and the Tampa FBI Field Office. All agencies have been very responsive and there has been consistent two-way communication. Serve as primary security point of contact with local law enforcement on behalf of the entire Tampa Jewish community. Requests for extra patrols and special responses throughout the area are made as the situations call for it. Keep the community informed on a timely basis of incidents that may pose risks. Ongoing security training for all TJCCF staff facilitated by law enforcement as well as internally. Trainings include, but are not limited to, active shooter, bomb threat, suspicious person, weather events, and medical emergencies. Security grant opportunities are explored and applied for from multiple funders throughout the year. Assist Jewish organizations throughout the area with the Non-Profit Security Grant program. 	N/A
