Please note: In order to be considered for a Toledo Jewish Community Foundation College Scholarship award, the Committee will consider academic achievement and financial need as well as the following criteria:

- a. Reside in the geographic area served by the Jewish Federation of Greater Toledo and must be entering an accredited undergraduate program as a **full-time student** at the **University of Toledo, Bowling Green State University, Lourdes University, Owens Community College, or a State University in Ohio (or in Michigan if Michigan resident)**.
- b. Review is based upon financial need.
- c. Must have achieved a minimum GPA of 2.75 after six semesters in high school or GPA of 3.00 for college students.
- d. Demonstration of motivation, ability, and potential.
- e. Demonstration of involvement in the Jewish community.
- f. Applicant must be between the ages of 17 and 25 years.
- g. Involvement in Hillel and/or Jewish Community life will be taken into consideration at time of any scholarship/grant renewal application.
- h. Applicant must complete the application which includes an **essay**.
