

# The Beth Weintraub Schoenfeld Memorial Israel Experience Program

*The Coalition for Jewish Education of the Jewish Federation of Southern Arizona agrees to provide a \$500 merit scholarship to Jewish High School youth living in Southern Arizona who meet the following requirements:*

- In 9<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> grade during the year of enrollment or 12<sup>th</sup> grade for the March of the Living.
- Attends an accredited and approved program, which is completed before high school graduation.
- Must successfully complete the requirements for the Beth Weintraub Schoenfeld Memorial Israel Experience Program as outlined on separate sheet.
- Must commit to graduation/completion of Hebrew High or other Jewish youth program.
- Informs the Coalition for Jewish Education of all scholarship requests to synagogues, community organizations and individuals.
- The applicant is responsible for ensuring that scholarships received from synagogues and community organizations will not exceed the cost of the trip itself.

As this is a utilization of the Jewish Federation's Allocation Program, a failure to fulfill any of these requirements will result in termination of the offer. If the money has already been granted, it will be expected to be refunded immediately.
