



Beth Weintraub Schoenfeld Memorial Israel Experience Program Description & Requirements 2018-2019

Goals:

1. To engage all Tucson Jewish teens in connections to Israel through education, participatory and experiential learning.
2. To provide a \$500 subsidy as an incentive to High school students for travel to Israel on an accredited peer program.
3. To learn about and honor the life of Beth Weintraub Schoenfeld who developed a love of Israel in high school that provided the impetus for her to make aliyah and raise a family in Israel.

To receive the \$500 subsidy, students must complete the following:

- Participate in the community Yom HaZikaron ceremony:
Tuesday, May 7, 2019, 6:30 p.m. at the Tucson J
- Volunteer at the Israel 70 Festival: **Sunday, May 12, 2019**
- Participate in workshop with community Shaliach/Shalichim (emissary/emissaries from Israel) on **Date To Be Determined**
- Return signed contract to the Community Engagement Department.
